BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Fire and Emergency Services Department is requesting the purchase of (1) 2023 Ford F-450 Frazer Type 1 Ambulance per Town of Flower Mound Specifications from Frazer, LTD. This equipment will be purchased through the H-GAC cooperative purchasing program. The vehicle is part of a budget amendment approved by Town Council on April 18, 2022, for the Vehicle Equipment Replacement Fund (VERF) budget replacing a 2015 Ford F450 (Unit # 61000-02) Siddons Martin Ambulance. Delivery of the ambulance is expected within 13 months after receipt of order. Frazer is offering a trade-in allowance. Additional equipment totaling approximately \$60,000.00 will be ordered at a later date and installed by Frazer, LTD.

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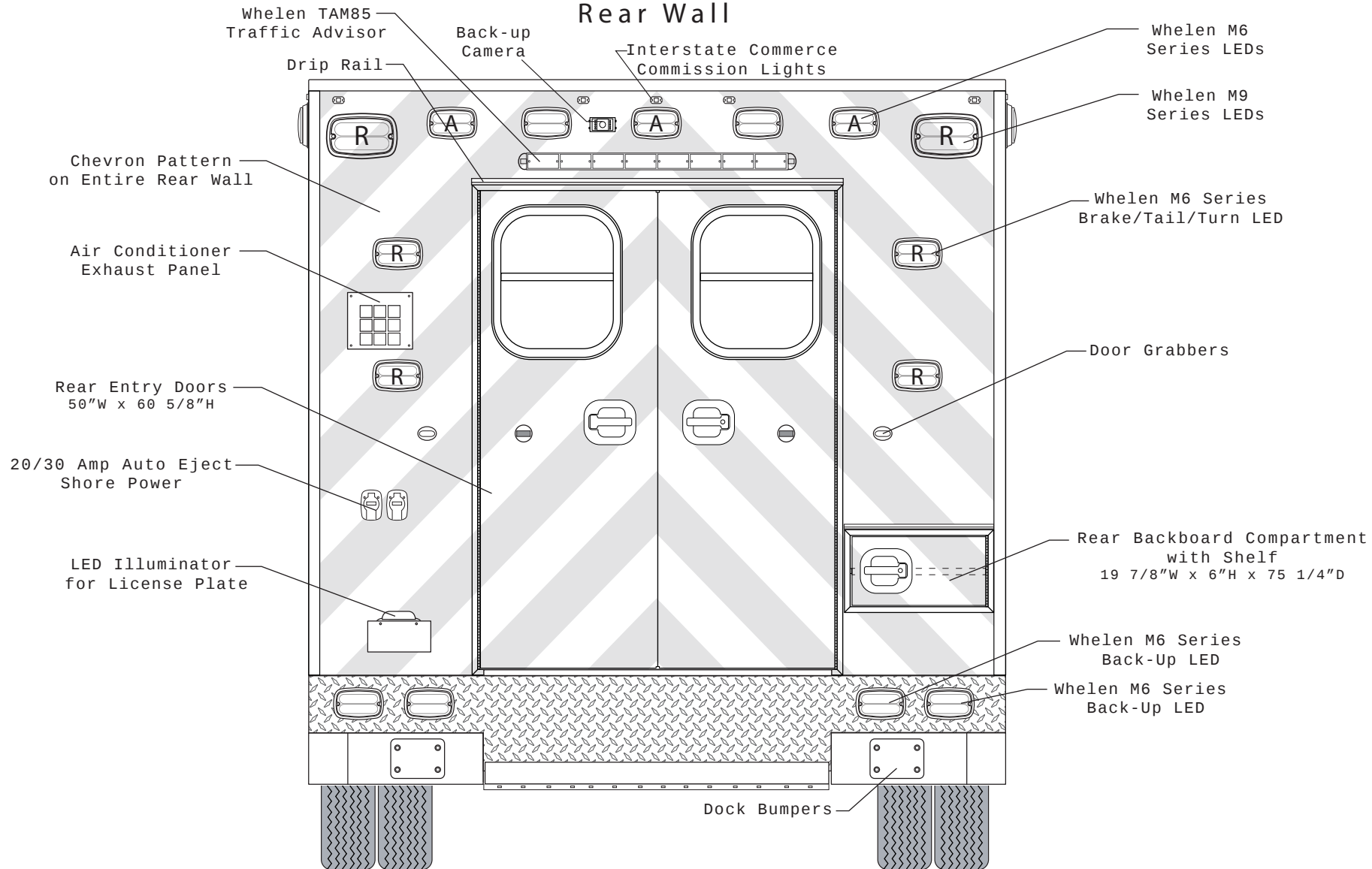

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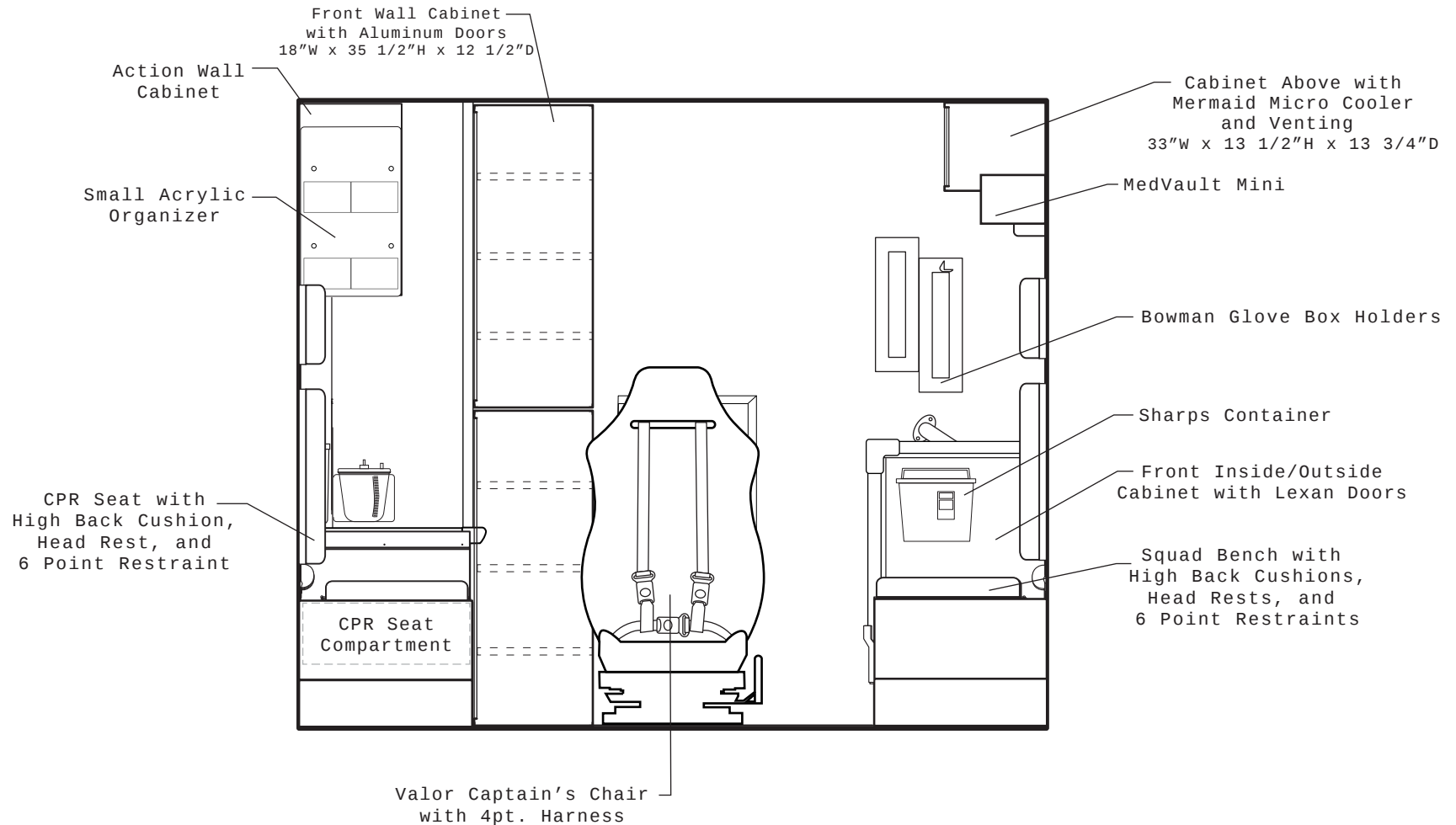

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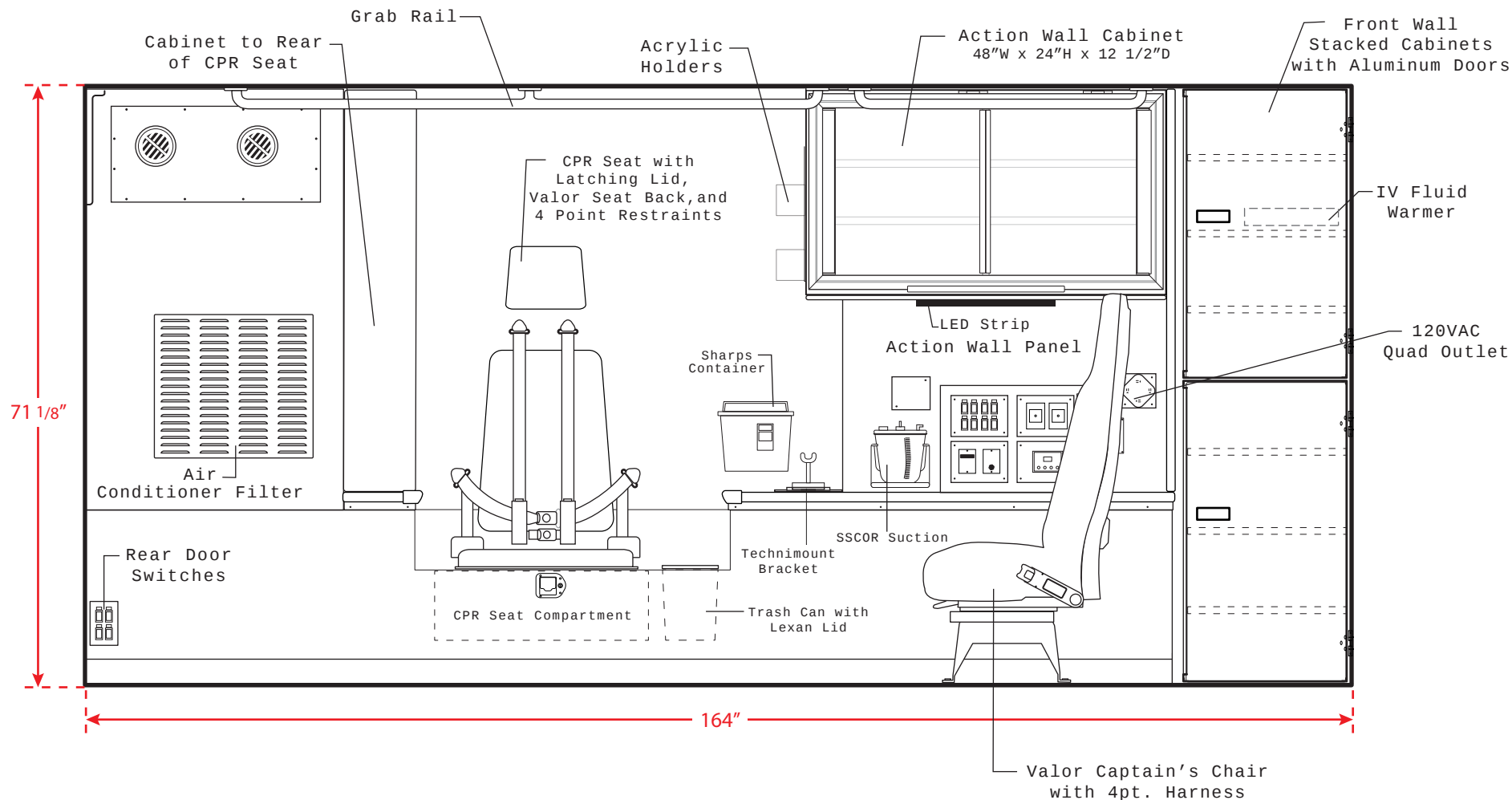

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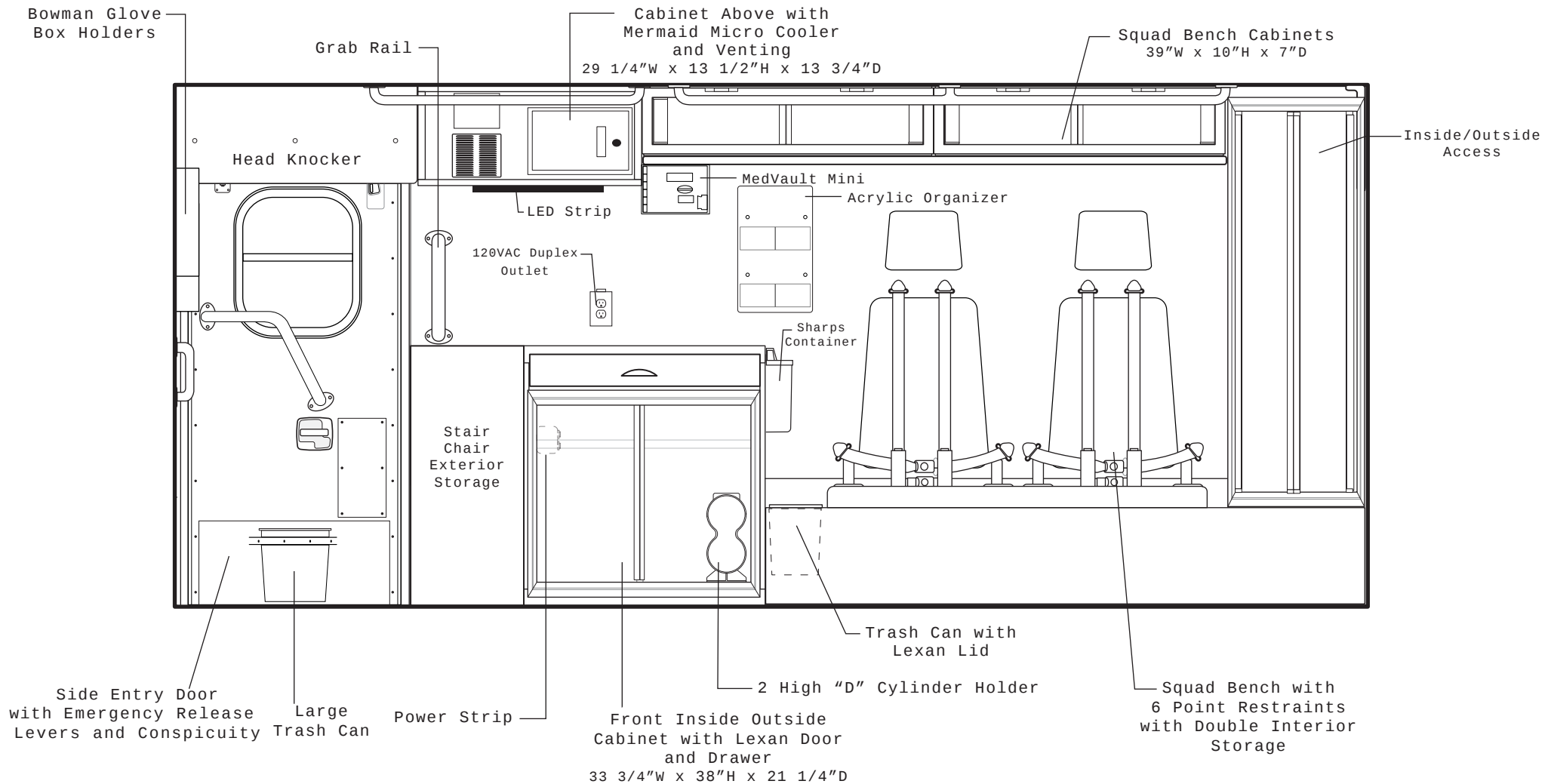

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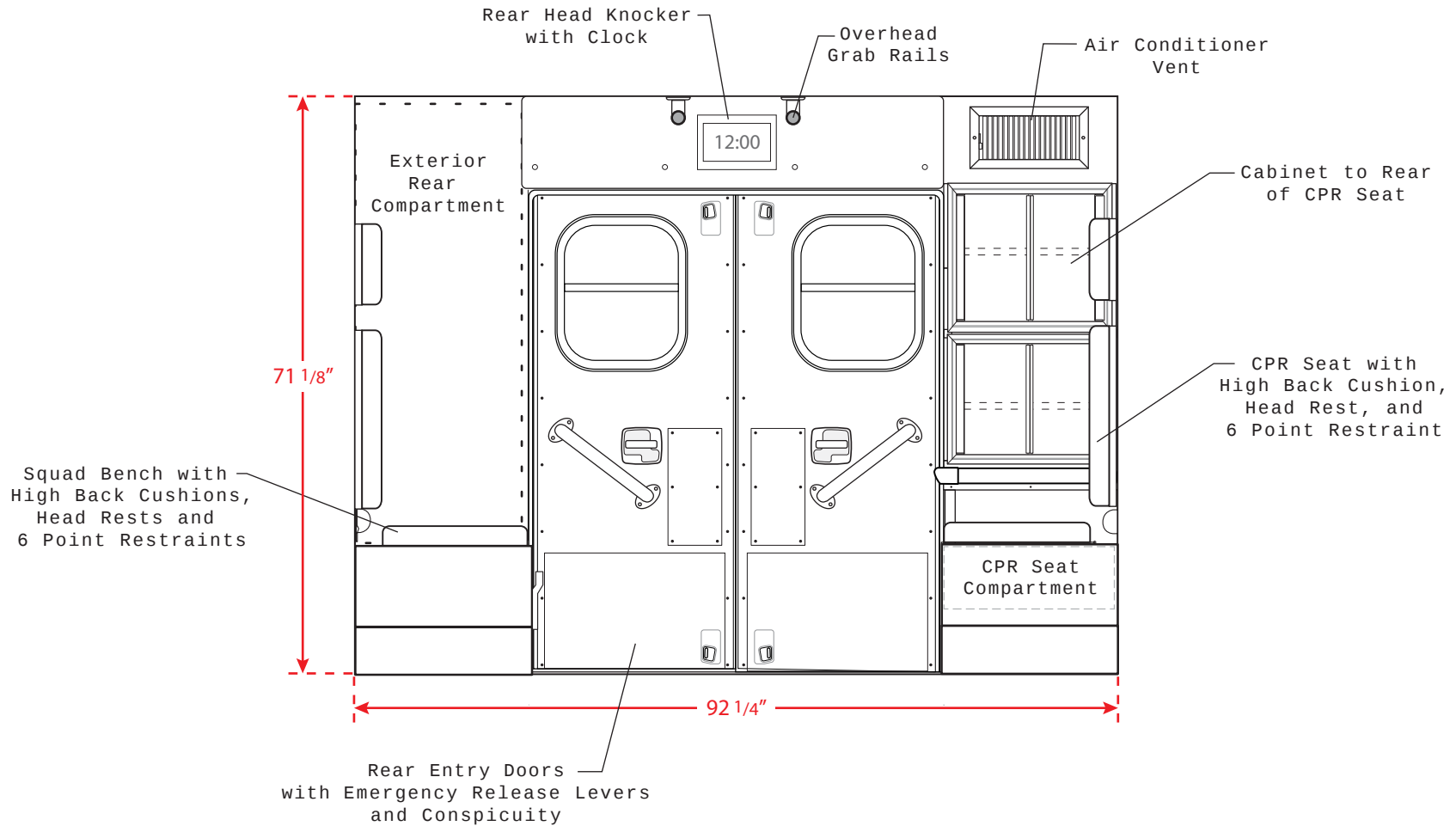

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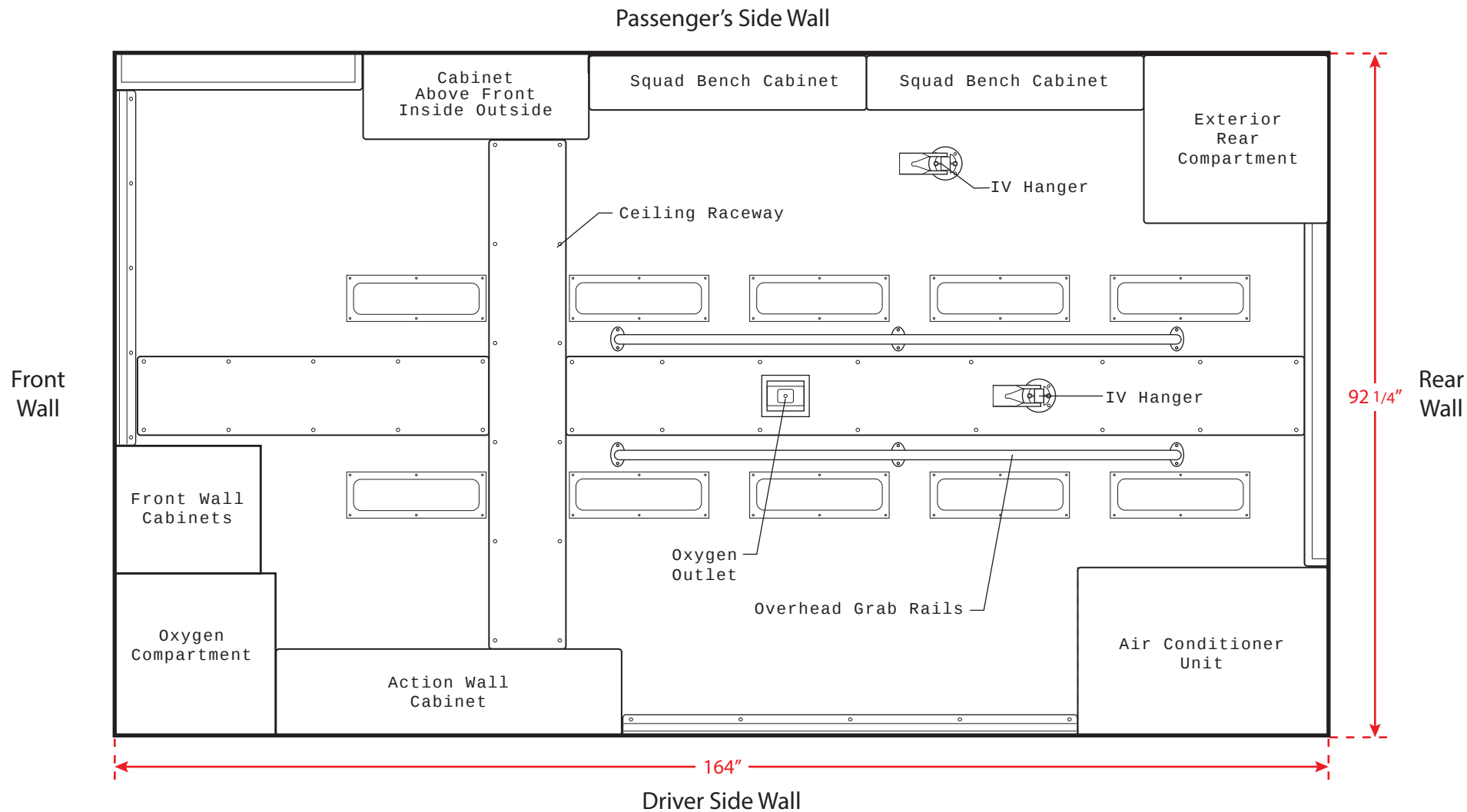

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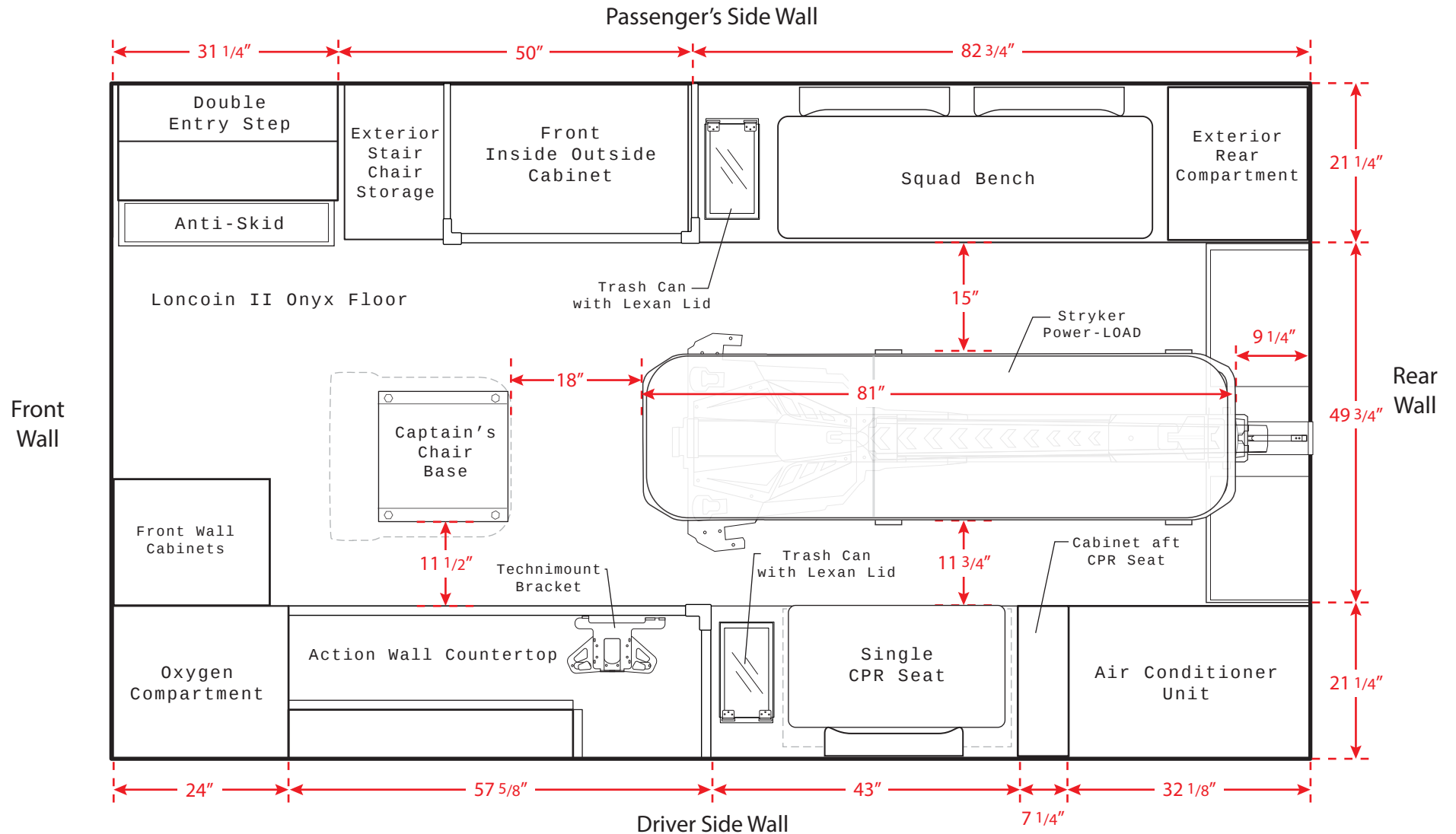
