ITEM: Discussion regarding the High Speed Enforcement Area program

BACKGROUND: Over the course of a year, the Town receives hundreds of requests for enforcement of speeding vehicles throughout Town. One of the tools in the toolbox to combat speeding is the High Speed Enforcement Area (HSEA) program. This program assists FMPD with documenting the areas in which motorists speed frequently and/or routinely and allow the officer a definitive approach to address this safety issue. This program began with speed enforcement of West Windsor Drive and has moved to other areas of the Town. In fact, once citizens became aware of this program, it has been requested on a routine basis repeatedly. The focus of this program is to minimize speeding motorists in areas in which citizens perceive there are numerous or continuous violators. Once this program has been executed in an area, there is a drastic decrease in speeding violators and increasing the safety of the motoring public and pedestrians in the documented area.

As part of the discussion tonight, the Police Department will inform the commission about the success of the program and how the program came into being and the criteria for the program. The Police Department has worked closely with the Municipal Courts and Public Works to make the program a success.
