ITEM: **FloMo Convos: Teen Series**

BACKGROUND: The Town created the community engagement initiative called, "FloMo Convos", in the Summer of 2022. FloMo Convos is a community engagement initiative that solicits feedback from the community in an interactive and engaging format. The Town utilizes the information shared by the community at these engagement events to assist Town Council with making future decisions that are in-line with the needs of the community. FloMo Convos: Teen Series is the latest iteration of the FloMo Convos community engagement initiative and focuses on the needs of the youth in the community.

The Town held two separate FloMo Convos: Teen Series engagement events at Marcus High School on November 16, 2023 and Flower Mound High School on January 19, 2024. Overall, 170 LISD students participated in the event and provided their feedback. Staff will share the feedback gained from these engagement sessions with Town Council. This item is also part of the progress toward achieving Strategic Initiative 9.2, to continue to expand FloMo Convos with 2 separate sessions in FY 23-24.
