Ron Miller announced the Flower Mound Symphonic, the Trietsch Methodist, and Voices of Flower Mound have joint Christmas concerts on December 10 and December 11.

E. STAFF REPORT

Tish Carter, Community and Cultural Events Manager, presented a year in review for Community and Cultural Events. Highlights included the Town Hall Arts Display that featured six artists in 11 months, the Community Mural from the Arts Festival, the Arts Festival at Heritage Park, Chalk the Walk, three added traffic signal boxes, Holi Festival, Children's Parade, the Art Wall at the Community Activities Center, the Diwali Festival, and the potential for the Cultural Arts Center.

Sue Ridnour, Director of Library Services, reviewed the fiscal year of 2021-2022. The library had 46,500 cardholders at the end of the fiscal year, a 32% increase over 2019 numbers. Visits were 213,170, a 21% increase, and 541,310 items were checked out, a 26% increase. Program attendance was 11,381, a 44% decrease as programming returns to normal post-pandemic. Fall programs include a traveling museum of Native American Texas on Monday November 7. There will also be program about the history of the Gibson Grant Log House on Tuesday November 15. The Flower Mound Philharmonic Orchestra will be performing a family friendly concert on Tuesday, November 29.
