D. STAFF REPORT

Sue Ridnour, Director of Library Services, shared an update from the library. Staff shortages in December and January were due to illness and retirements. Upcoming programs for the library included the Spring Gardening Series and African American Heritage: The QuakerTown Story. The Library is developing a Storywalk with the Parks and Recreation department. The Storywalk is a book placed in weather-proof frames in a park to encourage physical health and literacy. The library is planning to incorporate arts and crafts themed around the book selection. The Creation Lab opened in September and is averaging 25 visitors per week. The laser engraver has been recently added and requires safety training, as does the Embroidery Machine.

The new Community and Cultural Arts Manager, Tish Carter, was introduced by the Assistant Director of Parks and Recreation, Mark Long. Tish thanked Members Turner and Bailey for selecting Town Hall Art for display. There are plans for another community mural in Parker Square. Tish is working with the Geographical Information Systems team to establish a map of existing Traffic Signal Box art.
