F. STAFF REPORT

Sue Ridnour, Director of Library Services, brought the Commission members up-to-date on the Library renovation and expansion project. The Library is 11 days away from its grand reopening on Monday, November 2. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, there will be no large scale physical celebration. On November 19, the Library will be 35 years old. There will be a 35th Anniversary self-paced activity program instead.

Krissi Oden, Community & Cultural Arts Programs Manager, gave an arts update. The Chalk-the-Walk has been so popular that the Town is sponsoring a Fall Chalk-the-Walk on November 7 at Heritage Park. The next two or three artists have been chosen to display their art at Town Hall; Woof-A-Ween, dog costume contest, is on October 29 at the Hound Mound at Heritage Park; the first player for the mural at Gerault Park was painted today; and the first part of the Girl Scout mural at the CAC depicting kindness is complete. At the Town Council November 2 meeting, November will be declared Arts Month.
