BACKGROUND: The Town of Flower Mound is launching a new work session series titled, “Value of Municipal Services”, to provide Town Council and the public with a deeper understanding of the services the Town delivers to the community. These sessions are designed to highlight the scope and impact of municipal services, share recent trends and performance insights, and offer a transparent look at the cost of these services to taxpayers. Each session will also include comparisons to benchmark communities to help contextualize the value and efficiency of Flower Mound’s service delivery. The intent of this series is to equip Town Council and residents with meaningful information and education about the Town’s operations, while also creating space for questions, discussion, and deeper exploration of each service area.

This first session in the series will focus on Police Services. The presentation will include an overview of the Police Department’s full range of service offerings, performance metrics related to service delivery, and a discussion of trends in both service demand and operational response. It will also highlight recent accomplishments and challenges faced by the department.
